

Your improved bus service is about to start. More buses from Monday 30 November. New timetables from Monday 14 December.



9 new buses are being introduced as part of the NSW Government's Growth Bus Program which will improve frequency of service and deliver greater reliability, comfort and convenience to you, our passengers.

From Monday 30 November 2009 temporary timetables will commence for extra services on Routes **900, 905, 907, 909** and **910** using the 9 new buses. Please see our website for details.

From 14 December full new timetables will commence for Veolia Transport Routes **900, 905, 906, 907, 908, 909, 910, 913, 914, 916, 925, S2, S4** and **912** (renumbered **925**).

- ✓ Route **900** Liverpool to Burwood every 15 minutes in peak hours.
- ✓ Route **905** Bankstown to Fairfield every 15 minutes in peak hours.
- ✓ Route **907** Bankstown to Parramatta via Bass Hill every 20 minutes in peak hours.
- ✓ Route **909** Bankstown to Parramatta via Regents Park and Auburn with improved reliability.
- ✓ Route **910** Bankstown to Parramatta via Chester Hill every 15 minutes in peak hours.
- ✓ Route **912** Bankstown to Lidcombe will be renumbered Route **925**.
